

2018-2019 THEME SEARCH CONTEST

Many PTA units throughout Indiana include the promotion of patriotism and good citizenship in their goals and plans. Their activities vary from being as simple as including the Pledge of Allegiance and a flag ceremony in their meetings to being *THE* program at the meeting. There are citizenship bulletin boards, Red/White/Blue Days, and door decorating contests. Some PTAs celebrate Veteran's Day in a special, memorable way. Several PTSA's provide voter registration opportunities or arrange for students to serve as Pages at the State House. Many creative programs have been created to support our troops deployed in other countries. You do many things, almost automatically, related to citizenship and patriotism. Just stop and think about it!

To promote good citizenship, the Indiana PTA is again sponsoring the Student Citizenship Literature Contest for students in grades 4-12. The 2017-2018 theme is "What Is the Heart of Our Country?". I hope you will inform your students and your teachers of the contest early in the year and encourage them to participate. It offers a great opportunity for your students to think about our country, what it means to them, and what they can do for it and others. They will also be recognized for their work.

PTAs/PTSAs are invited to apply for the PTA Unit Citizenship Award. A plaque will be presented to one unit at State Convention in the spring of 2018 in recognition of their work this year.

Students will have an opportunity again this year to have input into the selection of next year's theme as they participate in the Citizenship Theme Search Contest. Use the official "Theme Search" form that is included in this packet. Please forward their entries to Indiana PTA.

The DEADLINE (postmarked/hand delivered) for ALL Citizenship entries is January 15, 2018.

STUDENT CITIZENSHIP LITERATURE CONTEST INDIANA PTA 2017 – 2018

THEME: "What is the Heart of Our Country?"

GUIDELINES:

- 1. Each piece of literature is limited to 2 PAGES, FRONT SIDE ONLY
- 2. EACH PIECE OF LITERATURE MUST BE TYPED (via computer), DOUBLE SPACED, WITH NO REDUCTION IN PRINT. Please use a font no smaller than size 12.
- 3. The student's name, grade, or school must NOT appear anywhere on/in the piece of literature
- 4. The piece of literature must be the original work of the student
- 5. Only PTA/PTSA schools, in good standing, may participate. To be a unit "in good standing" with the Indiana PTA a unit must submit the following to the Indiana PTA State Office
 - Officers' List
 - A current Financial Report following the yearly audit postmarked/hand delivered by the November 15 deadline
 - Current Bylaws...Reviewed and Approved every three years
 - Membership Dues postmarked/hand delivered by November 15th deadline
 - 990/990EZ or 990N (E-Filing)...Submitted to IRS & Copy turned into Indiana PTA
 - NP20...Submitted to Indiana Dept. of Revenue & Copy turned into Indiana PTA
- 6. Each unit may submit 2 ENTRIES PER GRADE LEVEL, Grades 4-12
- 7. Each entry must have a completed, typed Student Citizenship Literature Contest entry form along with the piece of literature inside a sleeve protector; one entry form is enclosed for your use; copies may be made for additional entries.
- 8. One Student Citizenship Literature Contest **Unit** Form must be included with your student's literature pieces. (One Unit Form Per School)
- 9. Entries may be disqualified if entry forms are not completely filled out
- 10. Each entry must be POSTMARKED/HAND DELIVERED no later than January 15, 2018.

- 12. Judging will be by the following divisions: Grades 4 & 5; 6 thru 8; and 9 thru 12
- 13. Only PTA/PTSA literature pieces with the theme "What is the Heart of Our Country" will be judged.
- 14. First place winners in each division will receive a gold medallion and certificate
- 15. Second place winners in each division will receive a silver medallion and certificate
- 16. Third place winners in each division will receive a bronze medallion and certificate
- 17. All students submitting entries to the State level will receive certificates
- 18. All winners (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) in each division will be invited to attend the Citizenship/Reflections Event held in the spring of 2017.
- 19. Points may be deducted for any guidelines not met.
- 20. Judging will be based on relevance to theme, grammar, completion of appropriate forms and content of literature piece.
